## Penannular Brooch



## **Materials:**

Wire, 16 gauge, about 6 inches per brooch

## **Tools:**

- Ruler
- 1 inch dowel
- Wire cutters
- Round-nose pliers
- Adjustable pliers
- Anvil and hammer
- File, grinder or wire smoother

## Instructions:

- 1. Wrap wire around the dowel. Use wire cutters to form the brooch.
- 2. Twist the ends of the wire outward with round-nose pliers, to form ends. Do not fully close.
- 3. File or smooth both ends of the wire.
- 4. Cut a 1 ½ inch or longer piece of wire. Hammer gently on anvil to straighten, if necessary. This will be the pin.
- 5. File or smooth one end of pin. Use round-nose pliers to bend an eye on that end.
- 6. File or grind a point on other end of pin. This doesn't need to be extremely sharp, just enough to help put pin through loosely woven fabric.
- 7. Slide eye of pin onto brooch. Use adjustable pliers to crimp ends, preventing pin from sliding off.
- 8. Hammer brooch gently on anvil, to even any twists in the ends.

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
